Today is fixed for filing of written objection and S.R. of the present Miscellaneous Case.

The petitioners appear by filing hazira. The opposite party, Lankabangla Finance PLC, also appears by filing hazira and raises no objection to the prayer made in the application.

Record is taken up for necessary order.

This is an application under section 19(2) read with section 57 of the Artha Rin Adalat Ain, 2003, filed by the petitioners seeking to set aside the ex parte judgment and decree dated 02.06.2025 passed in Artha Rin Suit No. 596 of 2024.

Perused the application, documents on record, and heard the learned Advocate for the petitioners.

It appears from the record that the suit was decreed ex parte on 02.06.2025. The petitioners have stated that they came to know about the said ex parte decree on 24.06.2025. Thereafter, within the statutory period, they filed the instant application and deposited 10% of the decretal amount amounting to Tk. 90,200/- vide Pay Order No. 0100A 2373692 in compliance with section 19(3) of the Act, which has been duly accepted and kept on record.

The Court finds that the application has been filed within the prescribed time from the date of knowledge of the ex parte decree and the mandatory deposit has been duly complied with. The petitioners have also expressed their intention to contest the suit on merit.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, and in the interest of justice, the Court is of the view that the petitioners deserve an opportunity to contest the suit on merit.

Accordingly, the application deserves to be **allowed**.

Hence

It is Ordered

that the present Misc Case dated 29.06.2025 brought by **Mrs Nasrin Sultana** under Section 19(2) of the Artha Rin Adalat Ain, 2003 for setting aside the ex parte decree is **allowed**.

Thus the ex parte judgment and decree dated **02.06. 2025** passed in Artha Rin Suit No. **596 of 2024** against the applicant is hereby **set aside**.

The Artha Rin Suit No. 596 of 2024 is restored to the file and the case shall stand revived to the stage of filing of written statement by the defendants (i.e., the present applicant).

The pay-order No. 0100A 2373692 for TK. **92,200/-** (representing 10% of the decretal amount) produced by the applicant is taken on record in compliance with Section 19(3) of the Act. The deposit shall remain in the court custody and be dealt with in accordance with law at the time of final disposal of the suit; any entitlement to refund or adjustment will be determined by the Court at any stage in accordance with law.

Serestader is directed to act on this order forthwith and communicate the same to the parties in the usual manner.
